

The Sri Lanka Veterinary Association (SLVA) stresses that resorting to importing eggs from non-bird-fit-free nations, which have had hind-(la outbreaks in the last six months will have dire conse-curacys as the more will risk entering and spreading in the island which is currently

"Set Lanka is a country tree from bird flu. Due to this move, there is a high chance of it spreading here. Set applering its poutry-exporting markets, spread of bird flu in the country will be a major factor in our expect market contracting further," SDAA President Or Dilan Sotharasinghe said.


#### **Dermatology and Surgery Webinar**
