

Instruction for Oral Presenters

Presentations should be prepared using Microsoft PowerPoint (.PPT or .PPTX) format. If you are supposed to use video clips for the presentations it should include as .MP4 format.

Number of total slides need to be limited to 10-12 and with concise messages. (Shorter scripts, more figures and concise table wherever relevant)

Your set of slides may comprise of the Title with author/s, and author affiliations, introduction, background, materials and methods, outcome/results, discussion and conclusion, future work and acknowledgement.

Presentation time:

For the **Clinical, Wildlife & Aquatic Animal Health, Animal Health, and Public Health Sessions**

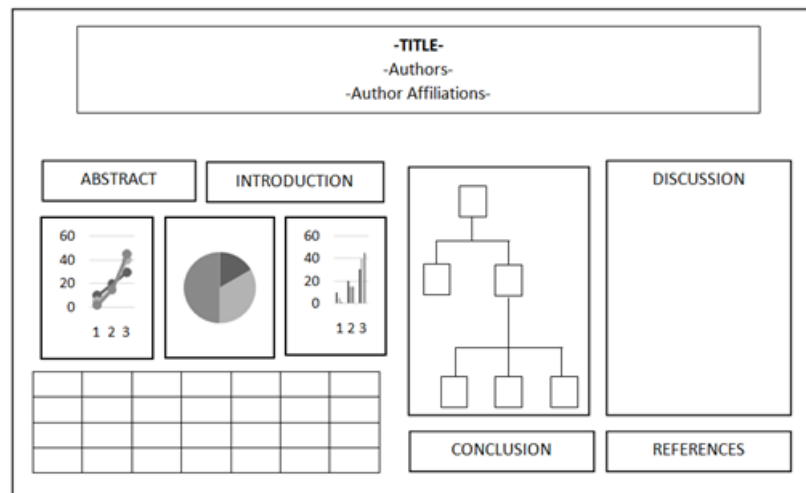
- Duration: 15 minutes (10 minutes for presentation and 3-5 minutes for discussion)

For the **Animal Production Session**

- Duration: 12 minutes (10 minutes for presentation and 2 minutes for discussion)
 - Your presentation file must be provided in a USB memory stick to the Session Coordinator at the venue in the morning of 28th June 2019.
 - In order to verify your participation with session coordinator you should arrive at least **10-15 minutes before the starting time of the session.**
 - Please rehearse your talk with your colleagues so that you are confident your presentation is clear, the slides are easy to read and understandable, and you do not run over the time allotted.
 - Be prepared to answer questions on your work.

Instructions for Preparation of Posters

- The display board for each poster will be **112 cm x 112 cm (44" x44")**.
- The Title, Author(s), and their affiliations should be indicated at the top of the poster.
- The lettering of the title should be at least 3 cm high and author(s) and their institutional affiliations should be at least 2 cm high.
- The text and illustration of the poster(s) should be readable from about 1 m distance (font size: minimum 20).
- The data should be presented in logical and self-explanatory sequence. A sample poster is given below.
- Poster should be mounted on display boards provided at the venue
