

Guidelines for Camera-Ready Abstract

SLVA- 78th Annual Scientific Sessions

International

- **Abstract Body:** The abstract text should be limited to **350 words**, excluding the title, author names, and affiliations.
- **Keywords:** Include **three to five key words** relevant to the study, arranged in **alphabetical order** and separated by commas, below the abstract.
- **Abstract Format:** The abstract should be written as a **single paragraph**.
- **Content Requirements:** The abstract should provide a brief overview of the **background, objectives/purpose, methodology, results, and main conclusions** of the study.
- **References and Citations:** References and citations should not be included in the abstract.
- **Abbreviations:** Avoid the use of non-standard abbreviations. If their use is necessary, they should be defined at their first occurrence.
- **Formatting Requirements:** The font and paragraph settings should comply with the following specified criteria.

- *Acknowledgements:* If the study has received support through a Research Grant, please mention the name of the funding agency and the grant number (if applicable) at the end of the abstract. The acknowledgement should be formatted using Times New Roman, font size 10.
- Please carefully review the following details and make any necessary corrections:
 1. Title
 2. Author names, affiliations, and corresponding author's email address (The first author must be the student/ presenter (underline the name of presenting author, generally first author). The corresponding author must be the main supervisor, who should be listed as the final author and marked with an asterisk (*).)
 3. Formatting of the text, including the Title, Author Names, Affiliations, Abstract Body, Keywords, and Acknowledgements (applicable only for studies supported by Research Grants).
