program too, apart from the vaccination, consultation and treatments, and it was organized jointly by SLVA, Colombo Municipal Council and TAPA (Tsunami Animal-People Alliance). Dr. Erandika Gunawardena, the immediate past president of SLVA also organized a vaccination and consultation program in Negombo. Several private companies related to companion animal

veterinary industry donated medical items and dog/cat food items for the program. The vets attached to the Municipalities were very enthusiastic in organizing the clinics. Several dogs and cats were vaccinated against rabies, dispensed worm treatments and also consultations/basic treatments done, benefitting under-privileged people and animals.



## Workshop on Fish Health Management


